## IDA Private Sector

The board of IDA Private Sector works for the private sector members' salary and employment conditions. The board of IDA Privat contribute to set the political direction for how IDA creates good and value-creating working lives for the privately employed members.

### Collective agreements

The board provides political advice when agreements need to be negotiated in the private sector.

### Election to the board of

The board of IDA Private Sector holds a general meeting every year in the first half of the year. The chairman and board members are elected for a 3-year period, while deputies are elected for 1 year at a time. In 2025, there will again be an election for the chairmanship and board positions in IDA Private. The board holds two annual conferences.

### Tasks and expectations for board members

The board holds 7-8 board meetings annually. In addition, there will be extraordinary online meetings when a decision must be taken on the renewal of collective agreements at the private companies that have a collective agreement. The members of the board can, according to their interest, choose to participate in political working groups when IDA formulates or updates policies within the labour market area as well as salary and employment conditions. This applies, among other things, to IDA's salary statistics to make all members as strong as possible, diversity and equality, working environment and strengthening IDA's efforts for elected union representatives.
